8. BOARDING FACILITY (IN VIEW)

The School provides a conducive and modern boarding facility for the boarding students. The school makes available bed-bunk for the students while other beddings like mattress, blankets, pillows and bedcovers are provided by parents. The school will soon have a separate school for the boarders.

9. SPIRITUALITY

The school operates a non-denominational Christian faith. A common mode of worship that does not contradict any denominational doctrine is adopted. We are completely dependent on the leading of the Holy Spirit for directions. However, students who are Non-Christians but desire to be trained in the Christian way are accepted.

10. HAIRDO

The hair should be neatly kept, either plaited with thread or woven without attachment. Hair attachments, coloured hair bands and dangling earrings are not allowed.

11. ACADEMICS

The academic standard of the School is highly commendable as this could be seen in our external examinations. Parents are therefore expected to support the school by encouraging their children/wards to be serious in whatever they are asked to do, providing a conducive learning environment, paying of fees when due, daily checking of their children's/wards' academic works, making sure they are punctual to school and sending reports when necessary. Please be informed that your child can be used for school programmes like television, Presentation, adverts, etc.

1. ENTRANCE EXAMINATION / ALLOCATION OF CLASSES

The School conducts entrance examinations for new students after which the students are placed in the appropriate classes based on his/her performance. It is of utmost important that Testimonial or last class result from the previous school is needed for qualification. Any student that is not found fit to be in a particular class may be placed in a lower class for a better academic foundation and performance.

2. DISCIPLINE

God's Grace International High School as a home away from home has the right to discipline any student whose behavioral standard is contrary to that stipulated by the school. Thus, disciplinary measures can be taken against any student whose attitude does not conform to the moral standard of the school and to the rules and regulations of the school.

3. PAYMENT OF SCHOOL FEES

All fees are paid in the bank before resumption date and the teller brought to the school on or before resumption. Cheques and cash payment are not accepted for convenience and security reasons. Fees are prone to review especially when the cost of services rendered move up.

4. REFUND OF FEES

All fees paid to the School are non-refundable.

5. HEALTH CARE

A sick bay manned by qualified medical personnel is available for students' health care services. Major health cases are referred to the hospital for professionals in the field to handle. Parents are to pay for any outside health service(s).

6. ABSENCE FROM SCHOOL

Students are not allowed to be absent from school unless due permission is granted by the School authority. Day students are not allowed to move out of the school premises unless it is school over. Frivolous activities like parties and unnecessary ceremonies are not granted to both boarding and day students.
